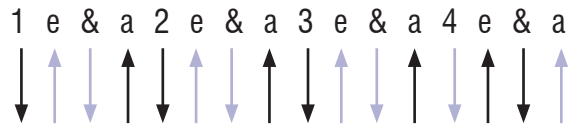


RANDY THE ROOSTER
